## **WHY Pivotal Response Treatment (PRT).**

- PRT is an Applied Behaviour Analysis (ABA) technique developed at the University of California at Santa Barbara, to overcome the many shortcomings of Discrete Trial Learning (DTL) and to be more naturalistic.
- Based on the principles of ABA and DTL, PRT was developed to be less rigid, involve more natural learning, and produce more rapid changes in children with Autism.
- PRT has been extensively researched and validated, with over 200 journal articles and books published.
- PRT promotes attention, motivation, language, social play, empathy and generalisation of learned skills to other areas of functioning.
- **It is also much more cost-effective and affordable.**
